September 22nd -Bicentennial Speaker

On Tuesday evening, September 22nd, at 7:30 p.m, the Reverend Dr. Thom White Wolf Fassett, who many of you know and whose family dates back to the first settlers of the area, will be one of our Bicentennial speakers.

As emeritus General Secretary of the International Rights Organization of The United Methodist Church, The General Board of Church and Society, Thom brings a rich and varied background of experience as he works in the field of faith, politics and issues of justice.

Thom is well known for his activities in conflict resolution/management and mediation and has participated in White House negotiations resulting in the peaceful “invasion” of Haiti by the U.S.; traveled to Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland on a peace mission with the President of the United States; negotiated Cuban principles of religious freedom, face to face with Fidel Castro, and played the determining role in breaking the impasse between the United States and Cuba in the case of Elian Gonzalez.
